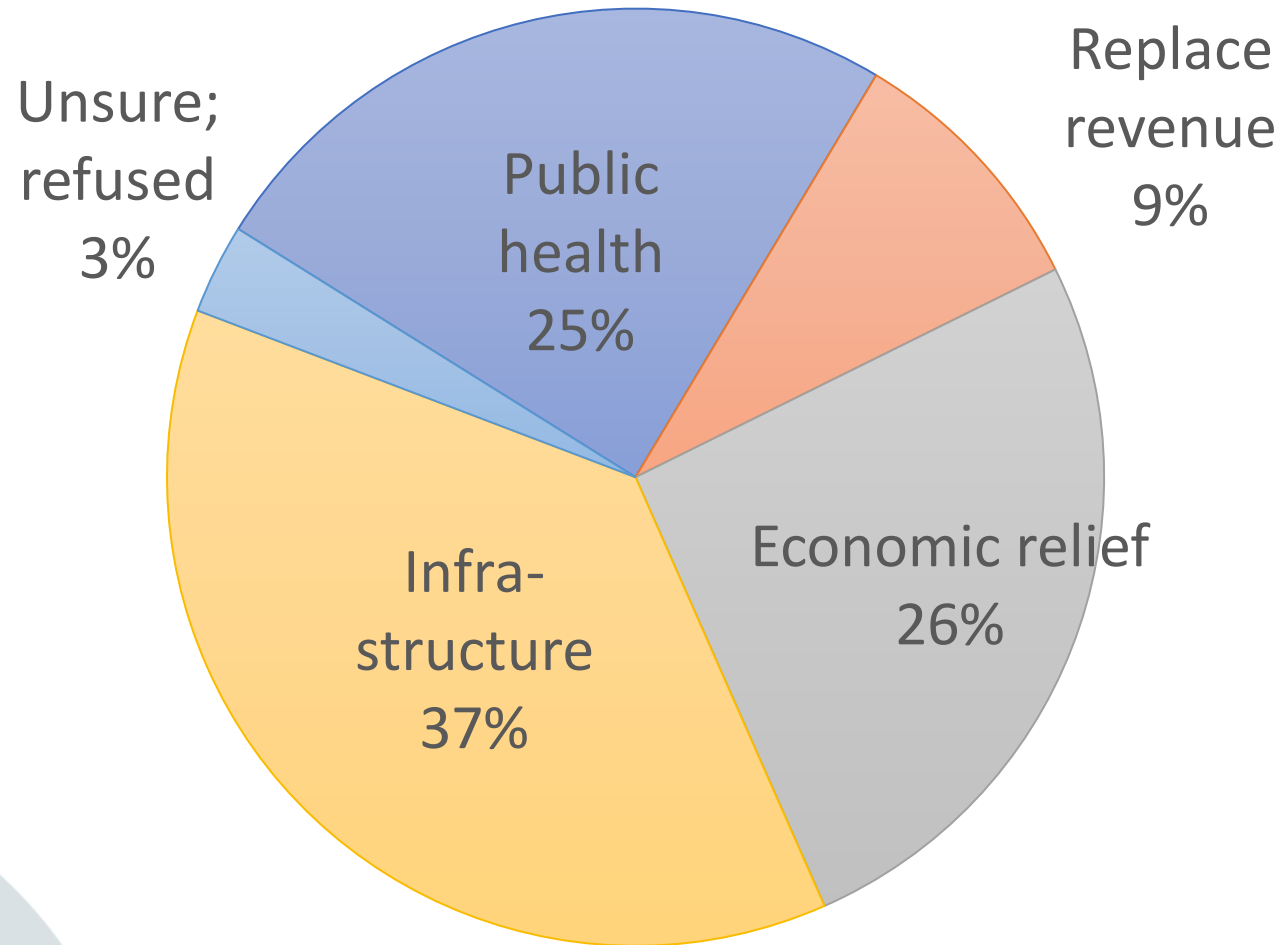

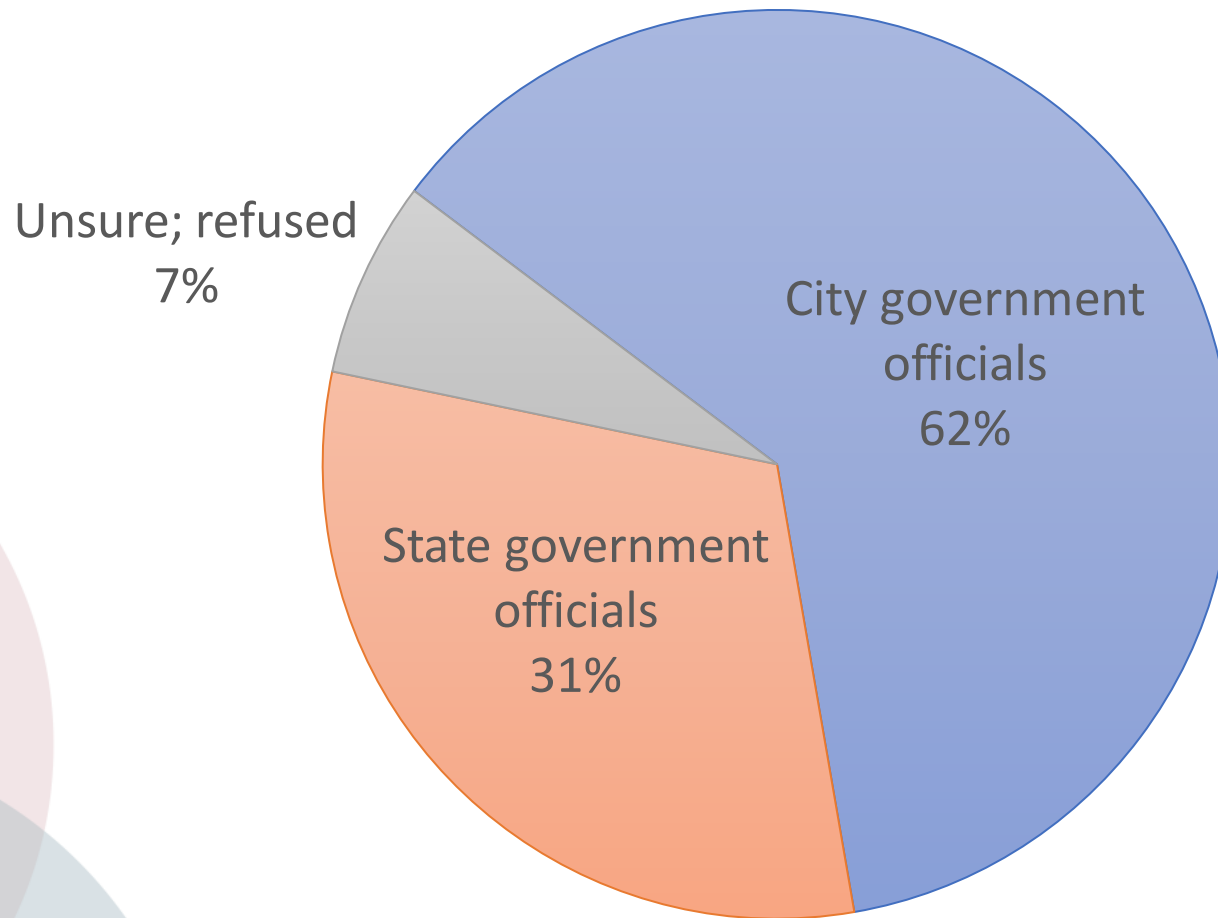

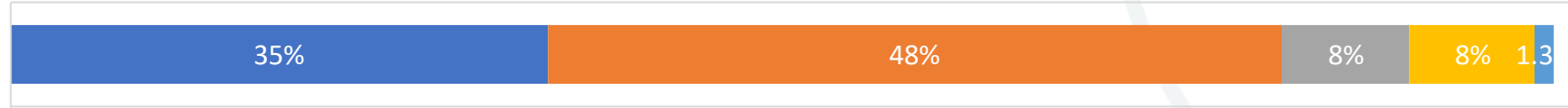
Who do you **trust most** to make decisions that affect your family, home, neighborhood, business and community?



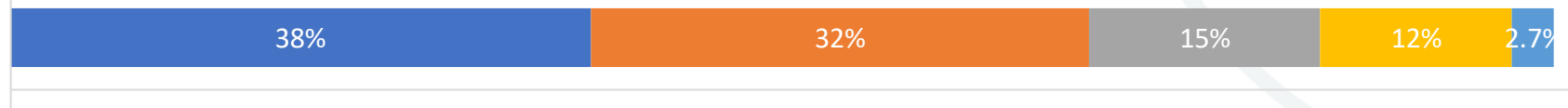

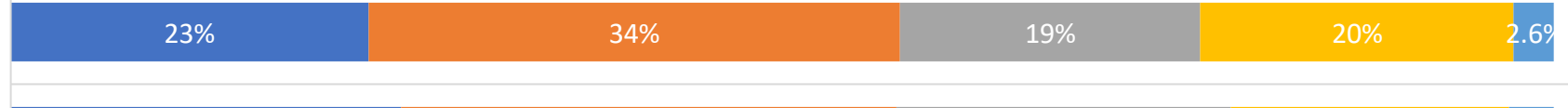

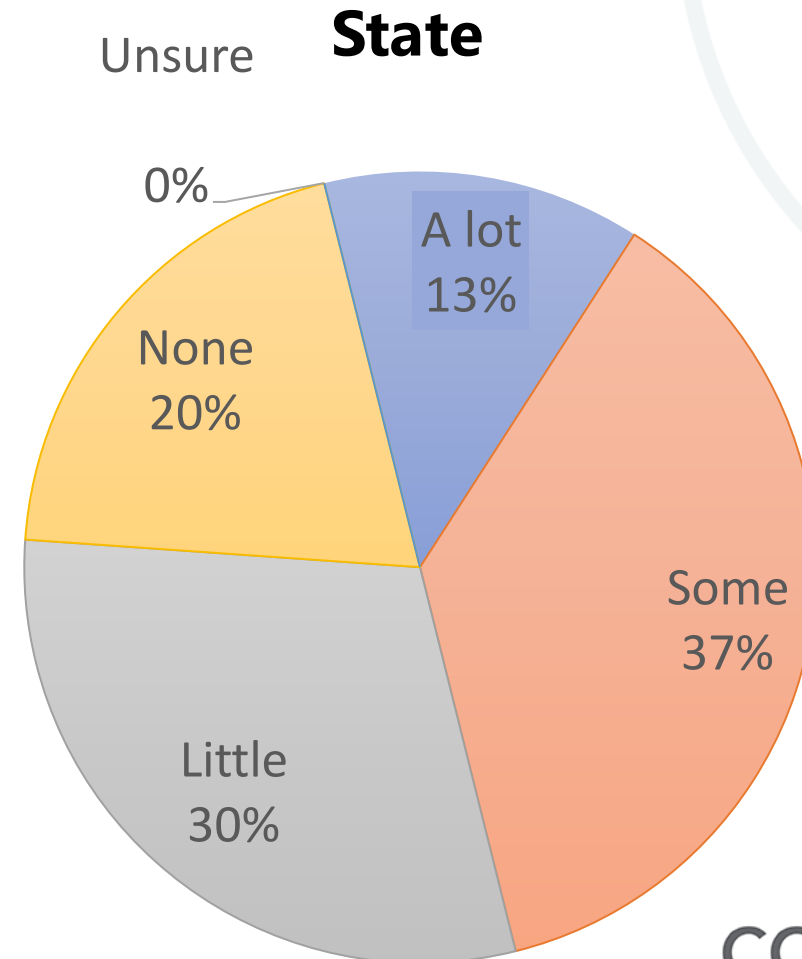
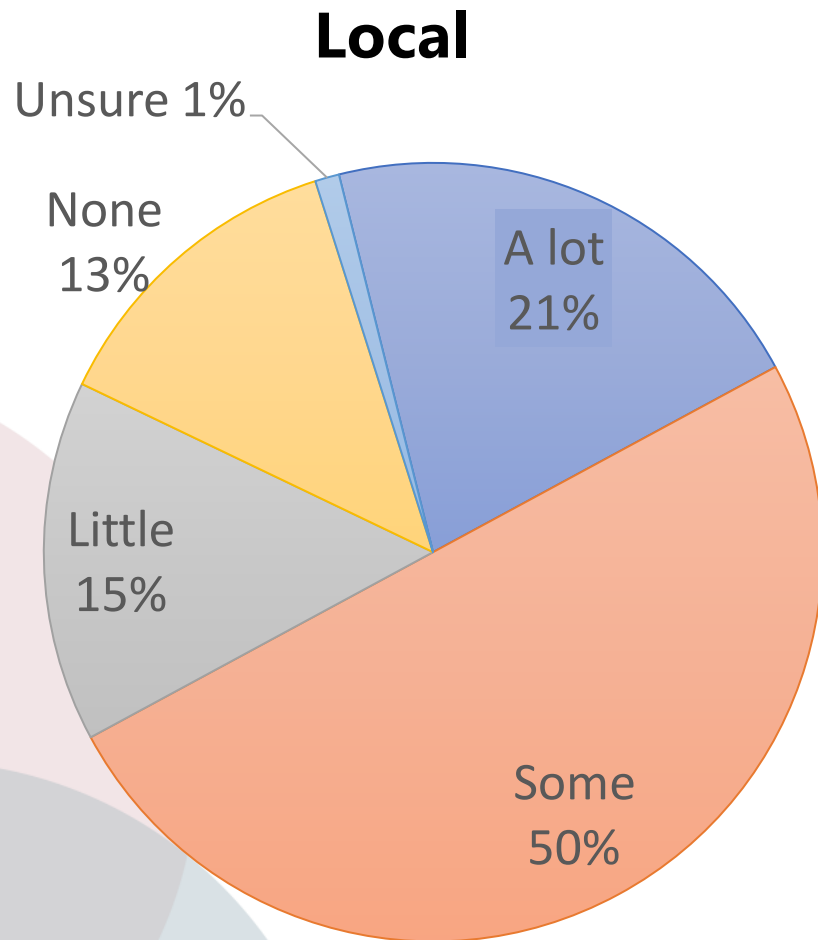

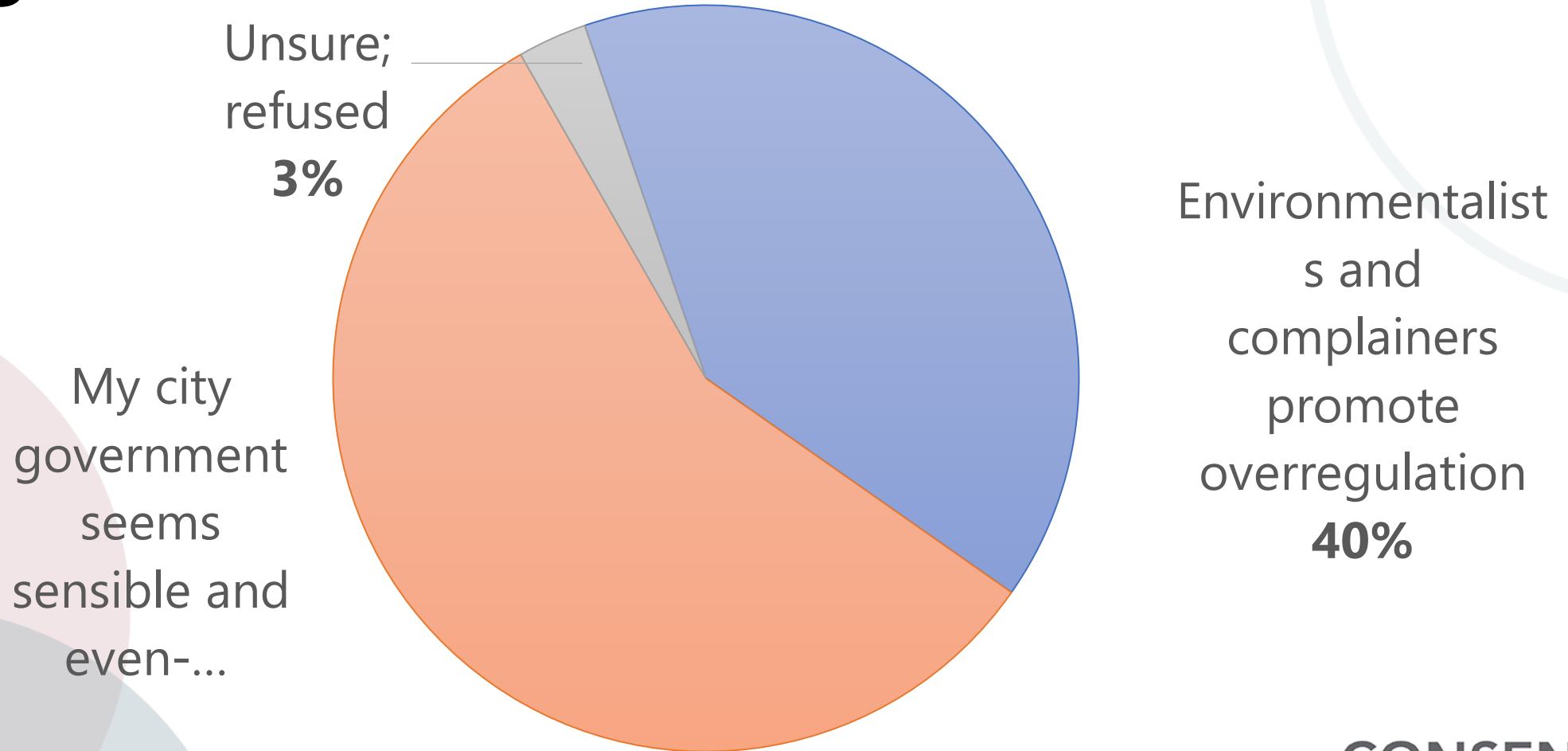

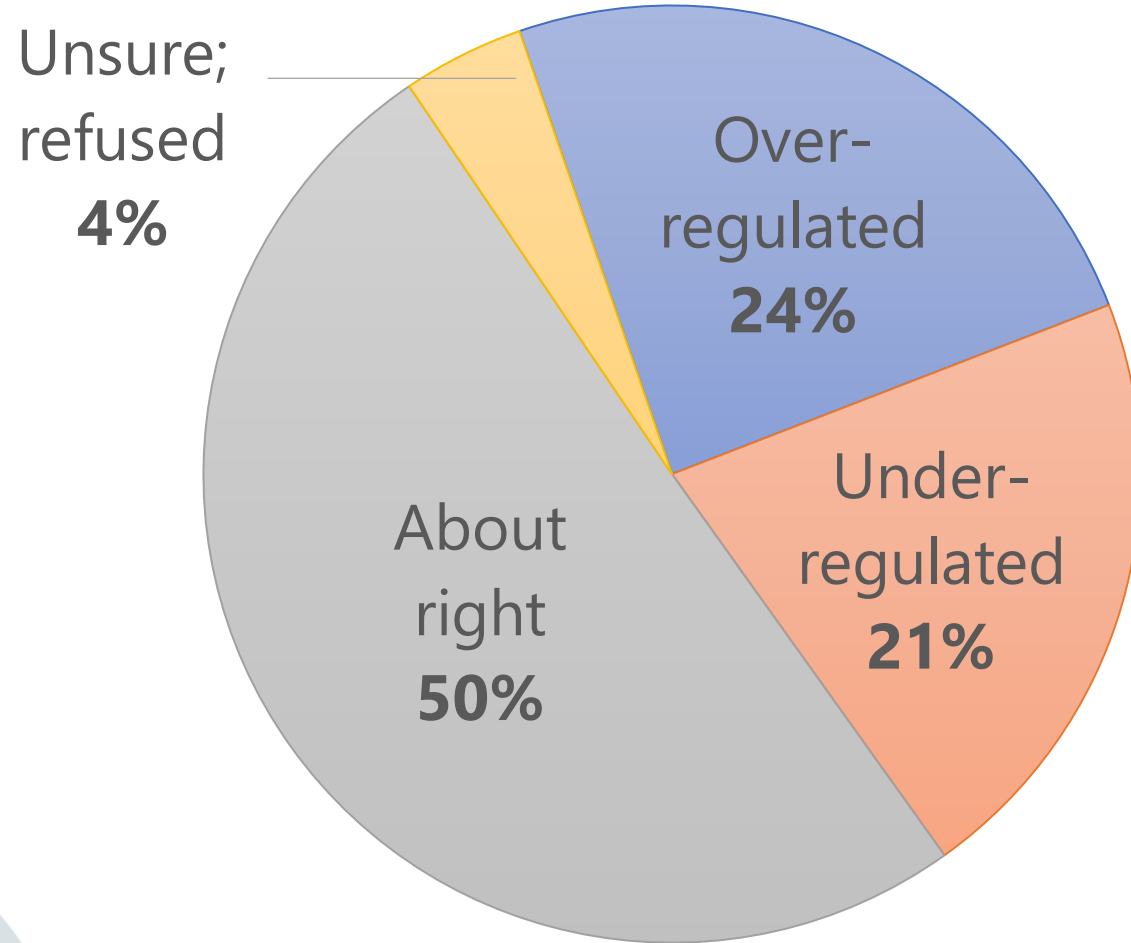
How much do you **trust** each level of government in regulating local business?



When it comes to regulation, is your city **sensible and even-handed** or do complainers get them to **overregulate**?

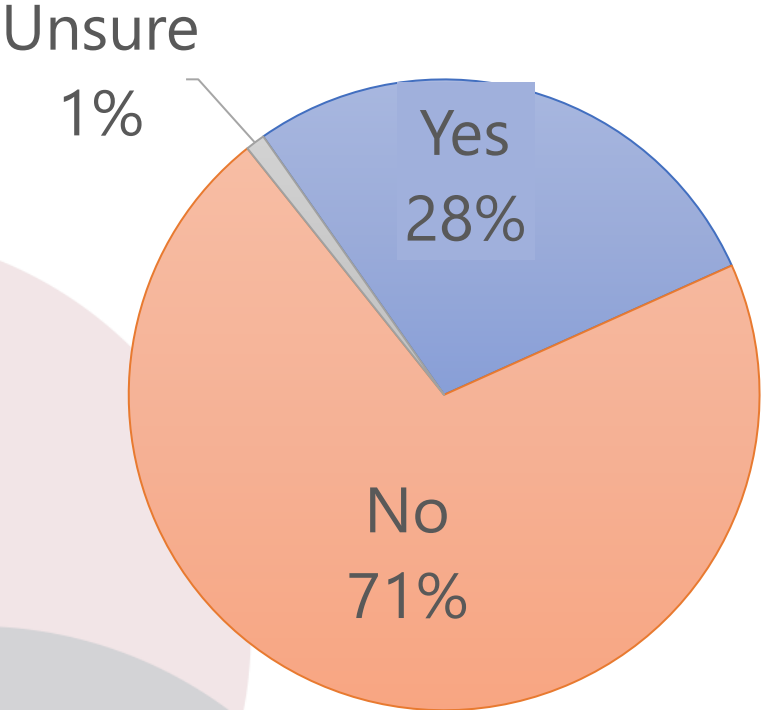


Is **Florida business** overregulated or underregulated?

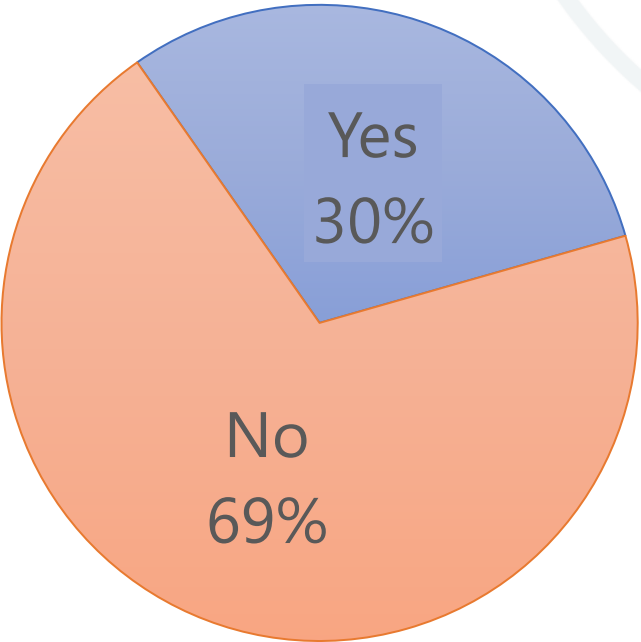


Have you ever personally spoken with a **business owner or operator** who complained about rules or regulations on business?
