

Summary of April 12, 2021 FLC Monday Morning Call-In

Amber Hughes Update:

- [HB 1](#) (Fernandez-Barquin) **Combating Public Disorder – Oppose Impact on Municipal Operations** – Last week, the Senate Appropriations Committee heard HB 1 and then passed it out of committee. HB 1 is now on the Senate Special Order Calendar on Wednesday, April 14 at 3:00 p.m. The same version of HB 1 was passed by the full House on March 26.
- [HB 1429](#) (Avila) **Tourist and Convention Development Taxes – Neutral** – HB 1429 is on the House Special Order Calendar on Tuesday, April 13 at 2:00 p.m.
- [SJR 1182](#) and [SB 1186](#) (Brandes) **Limitation on the Assessment of Real Property/Residential Purposes – Neutral** – Both bills will be heard on Wednesday, April 14 at 9:00 a.m. in the Senate Finance & Tax Committee. This is the second of three committee stops in the Senate.

David Cruz Update:

- [SB 266](#) (Perry) **Home-based Businesses – Neutral on bill/Support Amendment** – SB 266 will be heard on Wednesday, April 14 at 9:00 a.m. in the Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. The League is still opposed to the House bill, HB 403 (Giallombardo). HB 403 is still a complete preemption bill.
- [HB 421](#) (Persons-Mulicka) and [SB 1876](#) (Albritton) **Relief from Burdens on Real Property Rights/Bert Harris Act – Oppose** – The final committee stop for HB 421 is the House Judiciary Committee. The Judiciary Committee meets this Thursday, April 15 at 9:00 a.m. and HB 421 may be on the agenda. The committee notice deadline is April 13. The final committee stop for the Senate companion bill, SB 1876, is the Senate Rules Committee. The Rules committee meets twice this week – Wednesday, April 14 and Friday, April 16. SB 1876 is not on the April 14 agenda, but may be considered on April 16. The committee notice deadline is April 13.
- [SB 750](#) and [HB 337](#) **Impact Fees – Oppose** – The final committee stop for SB 750 is the Senate Appropriations Committee. The Appropriations Committee meets this Thursday, April 15 at 9:00 a.m. and SB 750 may be on the agenda. The meeting notice deadline is today. The final committee stop for HB 337 is the House State Affairs Committee. The State Affairs Committee meets this Thursday, April 15 at 9:00 a.m. and HB 337 may be on the agenda. The meeting notice deadline is April 13.
- [SB 64](#) (Albritton) and [HB 263](#) (Maggard) **Reclaimed Water – Oppose** – The bills are on the House Special Order Calendar on Tuesday, April 13 at 2:00 p.m.
- [HB 1053](#) (Overdorf) **Attorney General Designation of Matters of Great Government Concern** – The final committee stop for HB 1053 is the House Judiciary Committee. The Judiciary Committee meets on Thursday, April 15 at 9:00 a.m. and HB 1053 may be on the agenda. The meeting notice deadline is April 13. The Senate companion bill, SB 102 (Burgess), has two more committee stops.

Tara Taggart Update:

- [SB 402](#) (Rodrigues) **Legal Notices – Support** – SB 402 will be heard on Tuesday, April 13 at 2:00 p.m. in the Appropriations Subcommittee on Criminal and Civil Justice. This is the second of three committee stops in the Senate.
- [SB 522](#) (Diaz) **Vacation Rentals – Neutral** – SB 522 will be heard on Wednesday, April 14 at 9:00 a.m. in the Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. The League is opposed to the House bill, HB 219 (Fischer). HB 219 has two more committee stops in the House

– the Ways & Means Committee and the Commerce Committee. The Ways & Means Committee is scheduled to meet on Friday, April 16 at 8:30 a.m. The meeting notice deadline is April 15.
