Amber Hughes Update:

- [HJR 1](#) (Tomkow) **Additional Homestead Property Tax Exemption for Specified Critical Public Service Workforce** – **Oppose** – HJR 1 and the implementing bill, [HB 1563](#), is on the February 22 House Special Order Calendar.
- [HB 777](#) (Robinson, W.) **Local Tax Referenda Requirements** – **Oppose** – HB 777 is on the February 22 House Special Order Calendar.
- [SB 510](#) (Brodner) **Financial Disclosures/Form 6** – **Oppose** – SB 510 is on the February 23 Senate Special Order Calendar.

This is the final committee stop in the Senate.
- [SB 1940](#) (Brodeur) **Statewide Flooding and Sea Level Rise Resilience** – **Support** – SB 1940 will be heard on Tuesday, February 22 at 2:00 p.m. in the Senate Appropriations Subcommittee on Agriculture, Environment, and General Government. This is the third of four committee stops in the Senate. The final committee stop is the Appropriations Committee.
