- Property Taxes: Several property tax bills have been filed, including the bills listed below. At this time, none of the bills below have been heard in a committee.

   SB 852 (Martin) Study on the Elimination of Property Taxes Monitor
   HJR 773/HB 775 (Steele) and SB 1092 (Martin) Revising How Homestead Property is Assessed Oppose
   HB 787 (Chamberlin) and SB 996 (Collins) Revenues from Ad Valorem Taxes Oppose
   SJR 1016/SB 1018 (Ingoglia) Increased Homestead Property Exemptions Oppose
   SB 1308 (Ingoglia) Ad Valorem Tax/Rebate Programs Monitor
- <u>HB 503</u> (Botana) and <u>SB 1196</u> (Truenow) Local Business Taxes Oppose Neither bill has been heard in a committee. Both bills have three committee references.

- <u>HB 301</u> (McFarland) and <u>SB 1570</u> (DiCeglie) Sovereign Immunity/Suits Against the Government

   <u>Oppose</u> HB 301 passed its first committee of reference and has two more House committee stops. SB 1570 has not yet received committee references.
- <u>HB 991</u> (Giallombardo) and <u>SB 1242</u> (McClain) Community Redevelopment Agencies Oppose

   Neither bill has been heard in a committee. HB 991 has two committee references and SB
   1242 has three committee references.
- <u>HB 1209</u> (Steele) and <u>SB 1118</u> (McClain) Land Use and Development Regulations Oppose Neither bill has been heard in a committee. HB 1209 has not yet received committee references and SB 1118 has three committee references.

#### Matt Singer Update:

- <u>HB 209</u> (Snyder) and <u>SB 80</u> (Harrell) State Land Management/State Parks Support HB 209 will be heard on Tuesday, March 4 at 4:00 p.m. in the House Natural Resources & Disasters Subcommittee. This is the first of two committee stops. SB 80 passed its first committee of reference and has two more committee stops.
- <u>SB 180</u> (DiCeglie) Emergency Preparedness and Response Monitor SB 180 has not yet been heard in a committee. The bill has two committee references.

#### Rebecca O'Hara Update:

 <u>HB 1523</u> (Busatta) and <u>SB 1704</u> (Calatayud) Enterprise Fund Transfers for Water, Sewer, Gas, and Electric Municipal Utilities – Oppose – At this time, neither bill has received committee references.

#### **Housing Bills:**

- <u>HB 923</u> (V. Lopez) and <u>SB 1594</u> (McClain) Housing Tax Policy Oppose Neither bill has been heard in a committee. HB 923 has three committee references and SB 1594 has not yet received committee references.
- <u>HB 943</u> (V. Lopez) Real Property and Land Use and Development Oppose HB 943 has not yet been heard in a committee. The bill has four committee stops.
- <u>SB 1730</u> (Calatayud) Affordable Housing Monitor SB 1730 has not yet received committee references.
